# The Rector's message

Technical University of Cluj-Napoca has been included in the "club" of the 12 Romanian universities which have been awarded the degree of "advanced research and education universities" in recognition of its results. # 1. Cluj-Napoca

Cluj-Napoca, commonly known as Cluj, is the second largest city in Romania, after the national capital Bucharest. Geographically, it is (almost) equidistant from Bucharest, Budapest and Belgrade.


In the historical region of Transylvania, in an area of legend, Cluj-Napoca is eagerly waiting to be discovered. Once you arrive in the city and feel its vibration, you will be enchanted forever and as you connect to the specifics of the place, you will see why our city is called "Heart of Transylvania".





The ancient capital of Dacia Porolissensis, *Napoca*, was recorded for the first time more than 2000 years ago. The former Roman Municipium became, as documented in 1173, *Clus* (from Latin *surrounded by hills*), *Klausenburg* in German, *Kolozsvar* in Hungarian and *Cluj* in Romanian.

Cluj was known for its wine production and as an important center of trade. Because of its great importance on every level (urban, economic, political, spiritual, cultural), it became the most important city of the province. At the initiative of the catholic prince Stefan Bathory, the first university-rank college in Transylvania was set up in Cluj. Transylvania became a part of Romania in the year of 1918.






The Heart of Transylvania

# **Tourist attractions**

Cluj-Napoca has a number of landmark buildings and monuments, which are considered tourist attractions. The most important is Saint Michael's Church in the Unirii Square, built during the 14th century in Gothic style. It remains the tallest church tower in Romania to this day.

Also, the Fortress of Cluj-Napoca (Cetățuia), the Bethlen Stronghold (Bastionul Croitorilor), as well as the defense wall, are important medieval landmarks.



Cluj also has many theatres and museums, being an important cultural center: National History Museum of Transylvania, Ethnographical Museum, Fine Art Museum, Pharmacy Museum, Water Museum, museums of Babes-Bolyai University as University Museum, Museum of Mineralogy, Museum of Paleontology and Stratigraphy, Museum of Speleology, Botanical Museum and Zoological Museum. The National Theatre and Opera, Hungarian State Theatre and Opera, Transilvania Philarmonic are cultural landmarks with a great importance for the city.

Optional course for students during mobility - the Department of Modern Languages and Communication within the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca organizes free of charge Romanian language courses for the international students as well. The courses are held weekly, 2 hours/week.

Preparatory year of Romanian Language - available for all full time international students. The students who apply for this program will study Romanian language for the entire year and will only sustain Romanian language exams during that year. After successfully graduating the preparatory year, they will be enrolled in the first year of their specialization.

Taxi - the taxi fare is about 3 lei (0.61 euro)/km during the day and about 3.25 lei/km(0.7 euro) during the night. You can easily find a taxi anywhere in Cluj Napoca.

#### Dining

If you prefer eating out rather than cooking, Cluj comes with a great deal of cafeterias, restaurants and pubs, including the cafeterias of the Technical University: in Observator Campus, in the building on Muncii Boulevard, and on Daicoviciu Street.

The most convenient places to dine are, of course, the cafeterias, but restaurants and pubs are quite affordable as well.

#### **Medical services**

Important medical center, due to its recognition as a prestigious university center, Cluj-Napoca has various medical institutions, clinics, institutes and elite hospitals. Before entering Romania, foreign citizens need a travel medical insurance. In case you find yourself in need of medical assistance, you can go to any authorized medical unit, public or private.

There ore two medical cabinets free of charge for the students of the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca, located in Dormitory 3 in Observator Campus and Dormitory 2B Marasti, where you can get examined at any hour in the time interval of 9 am to 14 pm, from Monday to Friday. However, if a more severe health issue occurs, you should go to a hospital or clinic.



#### Transport in the city

You can travel in the city by bus and trolleybus - there are several routes for each, but the ticket is universal, meaning that it is the same ticket for any route of any bus or trolleybus. One ticket for trips within the city costs 3.50 lei (euro 0.8) and you can use it for one trip only (one way). Tickets have to be bought for each trip and validated on the bus. Tickets do not expire, so you can buy more in advance, yet after validation they will loose their validity at the end of the trip. You can also buy one-moth or half-month passes. You also have the possibility to purchase tickets via an SMS .

Taxi-the taxi fare is about 2.80 lei/km (euro 0.45) during the day and about 2.80 lei/km(euro 0.45) during the night. You can easily find a taxi anywhere in Baia Mare.
